From their first operations over Crete, initial operations over Italy, mining of the River Danube, participation in the famous Ploesti oil refinery raids over Romania, bombing and supply drops over the Balkans, and bomphlet drops (propaganda leaflets). Then later to shows of strength over the contested city of Trieste following the German surrender to repatriation flights following VE day and the final stand down of the squadrons at the very end of 1945. Soft cover, 240 pages.
